

How to create a new Discuss Data account



1. Click on "Sign In" to start the registration process.




2. Now you are automatically redirected to the <u>DARIAH Authentication Authorisation</u>

<u>Infrastructure</u> (AAI). If your institution is part of the <u>eduGAIN</u> network, you can register with your institutional account: Just type the name of your institution into the search box (search can take a few seconds), choose your institution and click "select".




If your institution is not listed, you can log in with "Dariah" (go to p. 6 for further instructions)


3. Now you should be automatically redirected to the Single Sign-on service of your institution. For the University of Bremen, this page looks like the following. First you must log in with your institutional username and password.




4. In the second step, you must accept that your institution provides the displayed information to the DARIAH-AAI.




5. Nearly there! Before you start, you must accept the <u>Discuss Data Terms of Use</u>. Please read the Terms of Use carefully and click "I accept". Afterwards you will be redirected to your dashboard – and you can start using Discuss Data!



6. If your institution is not listed for using Sign Sign-on via the DARIAH AAI, you must register a <u>free DARIAH account</u>. First, select "Dariah".




7. Click on "Request an account".



8. Now enter your details, including your institution. As your institution, recognized by your institutional E-Mail, most probably won't be found, the system will display a warning — chose "Ignore and Close" and proceed with the registration process.

Important: In the "Remarks section", please write that you need an account to use Discuss Data. Request an account, wait for an E-Mail from DARIAH (this may take a few hours) with your login credentials and log in at https://discuss-data.net/ (for first login, go to page 5).



9. If you want to use another account to log in into Discuss Data, go to https://auth.de.dariah.eu/CDS/WAYF, where you can change (trough reset) or permanently set the standard organisation that is used by DARIAH to log in into Discuss Data.
